



CPR Quality

chest recoi

Push hard (≥2 inches [5 cm]) and fast (≥100/min) and allow complete

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- Minimize interruptions in compressions
- Avoid excessive ventilation
- Rotate compressor every 2 minutes
- If no advanced airway, 30:2 compression-ventilation ratio
- Quantitative waveform capnography
- Intra-arterial pressure If Petco₂ <10 mm Hg, attempt to improve CPR quality

If relaxation phase (diastolic) pressure <20 mm Hg, attempt to

Return of Spontaneous Circulation (ROSC)

improve CPR quality

- Pulse and blood pressure
- Abrupt sustained increase in Petco₂ (typically ≥40 mm Hg)
- Spontaneous arterial pressure waves with intra-arterial monitoring

Shock Energy

- equivalent, and higher doses may be considered. use maximum available. Biphasic: Manufacturer recommendation (120-200 J); if unknown, Second and subsequent doses should be
- Monophasic: 360 J

Drug Therapy

Epinephrine IV/IO Dose: 1 mg every 3-5 minutes

Advanced Airway

- Supraglottic advanced airway or endotracheal intubation
- 8-10 breaths per minute with continuous chest compressions

Reversible Causes

- Hypovolemia
- Hydrogen ion (acidosis)

- Hypo-/hyperkalemia

- Tension pneumothorax
- Tamponade, cardiac
- Toxins
- Thrombosis, coronary Thrombosis, pulmonary

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
