Notice of Appeal Form (NAF-SBA) – Safe Body Art

IN THE MATTER OF: An appeal pursuant to Section 10 of Chapter 44 of the Acts of 2011, the Safe Body Art Act (the Act);

Where an applicant or permit holder has received notification that the Administrator has refused to grant or renew a permit or has suspended or revoked a permit, the applicant or permit holder may appeal to the Minister, by notice in writing, stating concisely the reasons for the appeal.

FURTHER: An appeal pursuant to Section 13 of the Safe Body Art Regulations (the Regulations), made under Section 33 of the Act.

An operator who appeals a decision of the Administrator under Section 10 of the Act must serve the Minister with a notice of appeal no later than 30 days after the date they are advised of the Administrator's decision.
