Retail Business Uniform Closing Day Regulations

Order in Council 2004-69 dated February 20, 2004  
Amendment to regulations made by the Governor in Council  
pursuant to Section 3 of the *Retail Business Uniform Closing Day Act*

The Governor in Council on the report and recommendation of the Minister of Justice dated February 20, 2004, and pursuant to Section 3 of Chapter 402 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989, the *Retail Business Uniform Closing Day Act* is pleased to order that the *Retail Business Uniform Closing Day Regulations* be amended in the form set forth in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of the report and recommendation effective on and after February 20, 2004.

**Schedule "A"**

**Amendments to the *Retail Business Uniform Closing Day Regulations*  
made by the Governor in council pursuant to clause 3(2)(s) of Chapter 402 of the  
Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989, the *Retail Business Uniform Closing Day Act***

- 1 The *Retail Business Uniform Closing Day Regulations* are amended by adding immediately after clause (o) the following clause:
  - (p) between the hours of 1 pm to 6 pm, a store the principal business of which is the sale of groceries or emergency supplies.
- 2 Effective February 23, 2004, clause (p) is repealed.
