
APPENDIX G



A L L that lot, piece or parcel of

land situate, lying and being in Torbrook, in the County of Annapolis, in the Province of Nova Scotia, bounded and described as follows:

BEGINNING at a stake set in the center of the Torbrook River, said stake being set on the West line of lands formerly belonging to James Jefferson;

THENCE running Southerly the course of Jefferson's west line to the base line;

THENCE Westerly along the said base line until it comes to land owned and occupied by Samuel McConnell;

THENCE Northerly along said McConnell's East line one hundred and twenty (120) rods, more or less, to a certain woven wire fence;

THENCE Easterly sixty-two (62) rods along said McConnell's line;

THENCE Northerly along said McConnell's East line and continuing in the same course northerly to a stake set in the center of the Torbrook River;

THENCE running Easterly following the center line of the Torbrook River to the Place of Beginning.

CONTAINING two hundred and eleven (211) acres, more or less.

TOGETHER WITH a right-of-way in common with all persons having a similar right to and from the said land herein described at all times, and for all purposes, for all persons, animals and vehicles over and along the present roadway one (1) rod in width running Southerly from the Torbrook Road to the land herein described and crossing land reserved by Martin Uhlman.

The said land is however, subject to a Deed of minerals and mining rights given to George E. Corbett in respect to the said lot of land by an instrument bearing date December 27, 1906.

THENCE North 73° 01' 32" East a distance of 176.82 feet to a survey marker;

THENCE South 76° 08' 41" East a distance of 119.54 feet to a survey marker;

THENCE South 51° 14' 11" East a distance of 124.01 feet to a survey marker;

THENCE South 39° 58' 49" East a distance of 218.46 feet to a survey marker;

THENCE South 01° 36' 11" East a distance of 96.71 feet to a survey marker;

THENCE South 49° 39' 50" West a distance of 290.97 feet to a survey marker;

THENCE South 52° 34' 32" West a distance of 271.38 feet to a survey marker;

THENCE North 27° 45' 27" West a distance of 501.66 feet to a survey marker;

THENCE North 30° 11' 07" West a distance of 90.75 feet to a survey marker;

THENCE North 52° 01' 23" East a distance of 243.10 feet to the Place of Beginning.
