


What you will need:

- 1. Ordinary household chlorine bleach (5.25%), without scent
- 2. Teaspoon
- 3. Spray bottle labelled "Sanitizer"
- 4. Water
- **5.** Chlorine test strips



How to prepare:

- 1. Mix ½ to one teaspoon (2–5 ml) bleach into one litre of water.
- 2. Test to ensure a sanitizing strength of 100 ppm.
- 3. Label the container "Sanitizer" so it is not mistaken as a food ingredient.

Tips to Remember:

- 1. Do not mix bleach with soap.
- **2.** Use chlorine test strips to check the strength of the solution.
- **3.** Discard sanitizing solution every 3 hours or as needed. The strength of the solution weakens over time.
