CONDUCTING REVIEW BOARD HEARINGS

Effective July 1, 2000, all Review Board hearings will be conducted by a Halifax Region Crown Attorney. An exception to this practice may be made in cases where considerable preparation time and/or a lengthy Review Board hearing is anticipated. The decision to make an exception to the standard practice will be made on a consensus basis by the Chief Crown Attorney (Halifax) and the Chief Crown Attorney for the region wherein the incident occurred.

No later than June 30, 2000, Crown Attorneys are to transfer the necessary information from their files for cases involving Review Board hearings to the Halifax Crown Attorneys' Office - Attention: John Scott. The Halifax office will keep the local offices apprised of the status of their cases before the Review Board by sending a copy of the Review Board's disposition.
