Order in Council 2008-341 dated June 24, 2008

Amendment to regulations made by the Minister of Justice and the Governor in Council  
pursuant to Section 8 of the *Summary Proceedings Act*

The Governor in Council on the report and recommendation of the Minister of Justice and Attorney General dated May 7, 2008, and pursuant to Section 8 of Chapter 450 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989, the *Summary Proceedings Act*, is pleased to amend Schedule 9A of the *Summary Offence Tickets Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 4/2001, made by the Governor in Council by Order in Council 2001-21 dated January 18, 2001, to designate certain offences under the *Water and Wastewater Facilities and Public Drinking Water Supplies Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 186/2005, as summary offence ticket offences and set the out-of-court settlement

amounts for the offences in the manner set forth in Schedule “A” attached to and forming part of the report and recommendation, effective on and after June 24, 2008.

### Order

I, Cecil P. Clarke, Minister of Justice and Attorney General of Nova Scotia, hereby order and direct pursuant to Section 8 of Chapter 450 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989, the *Summary Proceedings Act*, that the penalty to be entered on a summons in respect of an offence set out in amendments to the Schedules to the *Summary Offence Tickets Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 4/2001, as set forth in Schedule “A”, is the amount of the out-of-court settlement set out opposite the description of that offence, and the out-of-court settlement amount includes the charge provided for in, and in accordance with, Sections 8 and 9 of the Act.

This Order is effective on and after the making by the Governor in Council of the amendments to the *Summary Offence Tickets Regulations* set out in Schedule “A”.

Order in Council 2008-347 dated June 24, 2008  
Amendment to regulations made by the Governor in Council  
pursuant to Section 113 of the *Wildlife Act*

The Governor in Council on the report and recommendation of the Minister of Fisheries and Aquaculture dated April 3, 2008, and pursuant to subsections 53(2) and 113(1) of Chapter 504 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989, the *Wildlife Act*, is pleased to amend the *Fishing Regulations*, N.S. Reg 29/88, made by the Governor in Council by Order in Council 88-131 dated February 9, 1988, as amended by N.S. Reg 15/95, Order in Council 95-92, in the manner set forth in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of the report and recommendation, effective on and after June 24, 2008.



## Schedule "A"

**Amendment to the *Fishing Regulations*  
made by the Governor in Council under Section 113 of  
Chapter 504 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989,  
the *Wildlife Act***

- 1 The *Fishing Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 29/88, made by the Governor in Council by Order in Council 88-131 dated February 9, 1988, are amended by repealing subsection 3(2).
- 2 The regulations are further amended by adding the following heading and Section immediately after Section 3:

**Disabled persons**

- 3A (1)** The Minister may issue a General Fishing Licence at no cost to a disabled person.
- (2)** In this Section, "disabled person" means a resident or non-resident who either
- (a) has obtained or is entitled to obtain an accessible parking identification permit (permanent disability) issued under the regulations respecting identification permits for vehicles transporting mobility handicapped persons made under the *Motor Vehicle Act*; or
  - (b) has obtained a special number plate for their vehicle under the regulations respecting registration of mobility handicapped persons' vehicles made under the *Motor Vehicle Act*.
- (3)** To demonstrate that they meet the criteria in clause (2)(a), a resident or non-resident must produce either
- (a) an accessible parking identification permit (permanent disability) issued by the Registrar of Motor Vehicles; or
  - (b) a completed application form for an accessible parking identification permit (permanent disability) on an Application for Accessible Parking Identification Permits and Plates form issued by the Department of Service Nova Scotia and Municipal Relations.
- (4)** A completed application form referred to in clause (3)(b) is valid for 5 years from the date it was signed by the resident or non-resident's doctor.
