Schedule 'A'**Dairy Farmers of Nova Scotia Bylaws****made under clause 15(1)(h) of the*****Dairy Industry Act*****S.N.S. 2000, c. 24****N.S. Reg. 366/2007 (August 14, 2007)**

1 Subsection 27(4) of the Dairy Farmers of Nova Scotia Bylaws, N.S. Reg. 366/2007, made by the Dairy Farmers of Nova Scotia and approved by the Natural Products Marketing Council on ~~May 12, 2009~~ [August 14, 2007], is repealed and the following substituted:

- 27 (4)** If, because of a tie vote among two or more candidates, the election of one or more persons to the board of directors is not determined on the counting or recounting of the ballots, DFNS must determine the director or directors by causing the returning officer to:
- (i) place the names of each of the tied candidates in a hat; and
 - (ii) randomly draw from the hat the number of names that equal the number of positions on the board of directors to be filled, and each candidate whose name is drawn will be a director.

2 New subsection 27(5) be added following subsection 27(4)

- 27 (5)** If, for a reason other than a tie vote, the election of one or more members to the board of directors is not determined on the counting or recounting of the ballots, DFNS must declare the election void and must conduct a further election no later than 10 days after the date the election is declared void.

**Regulations Respecting Distributor Licence Fees
made by the Natural Products Marketing Council
pursuant to Section 9 of Chapter 24 of the Acts of 2000
the *Dairy Industry Act***

Citation

1 These regulations may be cited as the *Distributor Licence Fees Regulations*.

Distributor Licence Fees

- 2 (a) A distributor of fluid dairy products to whom a licence has been issued must pay a fee of \$0.016 per hectolitre to Council for Council services based on the total litres of class 1 milk sold in the province, which includes class 1 products imported into the province from other provinces and excludes class 1 products processed in the province and sold outside the province, during each calendar month, to be paid no later than 25 days after the end of that month.
- (b) Subject to [subsection] (a), a distributor of fluid dairy products with volumes of less than 500 000 litres per calendar year must pay no later than 60 days after the end of that calendar year.

The Governor in Council on the report and recommendation of the Minister of Health dated April 14, 2009, and pursuant to Section 45 of Chapter 3 of the Acts of 1992, the *Dental Act*, is please to approve amendments made by the Provincial Dental Board of Nova Scotia to

- (a) the *Qualifications for Registration and Licensing of Dentists Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 163/93, approved by the Governor in Council by Order in Council 93-858 dated November 2, 1993, in the manner set forth in Schedule “A” attached to and forming part of the report and recommendation; and
- (b) the *Specialists Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 164/93, approved by the Governor in Council by Order in Council 93-858 dated November 2, 1993, in the manner set forth in Schedule “B” attached to and forming part of the report and recommendation,

to create a new category of licensure for foreign-trained dental specialists, effective on and after May 20, 2009.

**Amendment to the *Qualifications for Registration and
Licensing of Dentists Regulations*
made by the Provincial Dental Board of Nova Scotia under
Section 45 of Chapter 3 of the Acts of 1992, the *Dental Act***

- 1 The *Qualifications for Registration and Licensing of Dentists Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 163/93, made by the Provincial Dental Board of Nova Scotia and approved by the Governor in Council by Order in Council 93-858 dated November 2, 1993, are amended by repealing [clause] 4(1)(a) and substituting the following clause:

- (a) holds a certificate of the National Dental Examining Board of Canada or a Limited Specialty Certificate issued under Section 7A of the *Specialists Regulations* made under the Act;
- 2 The regulations are further amended by repealing Section 5 and substituting the following Section:

Faculty of Dentistry practitioner

- 5 The Registrar may enter a person in the Dentists' Register on or before July 1, 2008, who is a full-time member of the Faculty of Dentistry at Dalhousie University and who does not hold a certificate from the National Dental Examination Board if they hold a degree in dentistry from a university approved by the Board and meet all the criteria in clauses 4(b) to (f).

**Amendment to the *Specialists Regulations*
made by the Provincial Dental Board of Nova Scotia under
Section 45 of Chapter 3 of the Acts of 1992, the *Dental Act***

The *Specialists Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 164/93, made by the Provincial Dental Board of Nova Scotia and approved by the Governor in Council by Order in Council 93-858 dated November 2, 1993, are amended by adding the following Section immediately after Section 7:

- 7A The Registrar may issue a Limited Specialty Certificate that permits only the practice of a specialty listed in Section 3 to a person who meets all of the following criteria:
- (a) they have graduated from any of the following:
- (i) a university or hospital-based post-graduate dental specialty training [program] that is not accredited through the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada or the American Dental Association Commission on Dental Accreditation, but they hold a certificate of completion or equivalency as described in the Canadian Dental Regulatory Authorities Federation's memorandum of understanding dated October 12, 2007, from a Canadian faculty or school of dentistry that is an accredited member of the Association of Canadian Faculties of Dentistry,
- (ii) a university or hospital-based post-graduate dental specialty training program that is accredited through the Commission on Dental Accreditation of Canada or the American Dental Association Commission on Dental Accreditation;

- (b) they have successfully completed the National Dental Specialty Examination set by the Royal College of Dentists of Canada;
- (c) they are in good standing in the dental profession;
- (d) they have paid the fees prescribed by the Board for certification as a specialist.
