* Layover Day: When, on a multi-day charter, the group remains stationary for one or more days and has minimal use of the vehicle, travelling 25 km or less per day.

Additional Charges:

1. Drivers Accommodation: \$110.00 per night, unless supplied by the customer.
2. Drivers meals (per driver): Maximum per day - \$75.00, unless supplied by the customer.
3. Misc. Items: Tax, bridge and ferry tolls, road tolls, parking, attractions, tour guides. The above costs are additional to the rates shown if so required.
4. Cancellation: Group tours – 20% required as a deposit. If cancelled within 14 days prior to departure, then the deposit is retained.

If notice of cancellation is given twelve (12) or more hours prior to the scheduled time of departure from the terminal, no cancellation charge will apply beyond the retention of the deposit.

If notice of cancellation is given less than twelve (12) hours prior to the scheduled time of departure from the terminal, a cancellation charge will apply, such charge equal to the greater of (1) \$125.00 per bus, or (2) the deadhead rate multiplied by the total number of kilometers travelled. This charge will apply in addition to the retention of the 20% required deposit noted above.

Notice of Cancellation must be given during regular business hours: Monday to Friday between 8:00 am and 5:00 pm

5. Additional Hours: Quoted rates are based on the Itinerary. It is the responsibility of the customer to provide the Company with both an accurate route that the Charter customer will take during their Charter and the commencement and conclusion dates of the Charter. The greater of the additional hours or kilometers over and above the original booking will be charged at the filed rate with the Board.

If an additional driver is required, the customer shall pay any costs related to this request. The requirement for a second driver would arise if the trip required a driving time beyond the limit of hours on duty or driving stipulated by the National Safety Code.

6. School Discount fares: A maximum of 10% tariff reduction of hourly, kilometers or daily rates shall apply for school groups of students and chaperones up to and including high school groups and shall also apply to youth groups of participants up to 20 years of age.

Charter Rate Computation:

Trips One Day or Less:

Charge to customer shall be the greater of (i) the Hourly Rate, or (ii) the combined Base Rate, Deadhead Rate and Waiting Time.

Trips Greater than One Day:

Charge to customer shall be the greater of (i) the Daily Rate, or (ii) the combined Base Rate, Deadhead Rate and Waiting Time.

Definitions:

- A. Itinerary - the route that the Charter customer will take during their Charter as well as the commencement and conclusion dates of the Charter, all of which is to be provided by the Charter customer. This term also includes the total hours during which the driver is to remain on service, and the approximate daily mileage for the Charter.
- B. Base Rate - the rate to be charged, on a per kilometer basis, against any mileage that the chartered bus travels without passengers from the time it leaves the terminal until it returns to the terminal at the end of a Charter trip.
- C. Charter - the exclusive use of one or more by any person or group of the Company's Buses.
- D. Deadhead Rate - the rate to be charged, on a per kilometer basis, against any mileage that the chartered bus travels without passengers from the time it leaves the terminal until it returns to the terminal at the end of a Charter trip.
- E. Hourly Rate - the rate to be charged, on an hourly basis, for each hour the chartered bus travels with or without passengers, from the time it leaves the terminal until it returns to the terminal at the end of a Charter trip. For the purpose of applying this definition to the calculation of rates, any part hour shall be increased to the nearest whole hour.
- F.
