NOW KNOW YE THAT WE, by and with the advice of the Executive Council of Nova Scotia, do by this Our Proclamation order and declare that Chapter 15 of the Acts of 2004, *An Act to Amend Chapter 17 of the Acts of 1998, the Mi'kmaq Education Act*, do come into force on and not before October 23, 2007, with effect on and after April 1, 2004, of which all persons concerned are to take notice and govern themselves accordingly.
