### Schedule A

Amendment to the *Milk Pricing Regulations* made by the Dairy Farmers of Nova Scotia under clauses 14(1)(c) and 15(1)(g) of Chapter 24 of the Acts of 2000, the *Dairy Industry Act* 

The *Milk Pricing Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 84/2008, made by the Dairy Farmers of Nova Scotia on September 21, 2007, and approved by the Natural Products Marketing Council on February 12, 2008, are amended by repealing subsection 3(1) and substituting the following subsection:

3 (1) Except as provided in subsection (2), the prices payable by processors in Nova Scotia for milk components are as set out in the following table, and are payable on a free on board (FOB) plant basis:

Whereas the purpose of the *Petroleum Products Pricing Regulations* is to ensure just and reasonable prices for specified petroleum products taking into consideration the objectives of preserving the availability of such products in rural areas, stabilizing prices of such products and minimizing the variances in prices of such products across the Province;

**And whereas** the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board ("Board") considered the manner in which it would proceed to set petroleum prices in its decision, 2006 NSUARB 108, issued on October 16, 2006;

**And whereas** the average of the average of the daily high and low reported product prices (in Canadian cents) for the week ended December 22, 2010, are:

64.4¢ per litre

Grade 1 Regular gasoline

Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil

66.8¢ per litre

Now therefore the Board prescribes the benchmark prices for petroleum products to be:

Gasoline:

Grade 1  $64.4\phi$  per litre Grade 2  $67.4\phi$  per litre Grade 3  $70.4\phi$  per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil  $66.8\phi$  per litre

And now therefore the Board has determined, based on historical data regarding price changes and to achieve revenue neutrality, it is appropriate to apply, and the Board so orders, forward averaging corrections of:

Gasoline: plus 0.8¢ per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil: plus 0.8¢ per litre

And whereas a winter blending adjustment of plus 3.2¢ per litre is required for ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil;

**And now therefore** the Board prescribes the prices for petroleum products as set forth in Schedule "A" effective on and after 12:01 a.m., December 24, 2010.

**Now therefore** the Board prescribes the benchmark prices for petroleum products to be:

**And now therefore** the Board has determined, based on historical data regarding price changes and to achieve revenue neutrality, it is appropriate to apply, and the Board so orders, forward averaging corrections of:

Gasoline: plus  $0.6\phi$  per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil: plus  $0.8\phi$  per litre

And whereas a winter blending adjustment of plus 3.0¢ per litre is required for ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil;

**And now therefore** the Board prescribes the prices for petroleum products as set forth in Schedule "A" effective on and after 12:01 a.m., December 31, 2010.
