Whereas the purpose of the *Petroleum Products Pricing Regulations* is to ensure just and reasonable prices for specified petroleum products taking into consideration the objectives of preserving the availability of such products in rural areas, stabilizing prices of such products and minimizing the variances in prices of such products across the Province;

**And whereas** the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board ("Board") considered the manner in which it would proceed to set petroleum prices in its decision, 2006 NSUARB 108, issued on October 16, 2006;

**And whereas** the Board revised the retail margin and transportation allowance effective January 6, 2012, in its Decision 2011 NSUARB 181, issued on November 23, 2011;

**And whereas** the average of the average of the daily high and low reported product prices (in Canadian cents) for the week ended February 1, 2012, are:

Grade 1 Regular gasoline 77.1¢ per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil 81.2¢ per litre

Now therefore the Board prescribes the benchmark prices for petroleum products to be:

## Gasoline:

Grade 1 77.1¢ per litre
Grade 2 80.1¢ per litre
Grade 3 83.1¢ per litre
Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil 81.2¢ per litre

**And now therefore** the Board has determined, based on historical data regarding price changes and to achieve revenue neutrality, it is appropriate to apply, and the Board so orders, forward averaging corrections of:

Gasoline: plus 0.8¢ per litre

Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil: nil

And whereas a winter blending adjustment of plus 4.1¢ per litre is required for ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil;

**And now therefore** the Board prescribes the prices for petroleum products as set forth in Schedule "A" effective on and after 12:01 a.m., February 3, 2012.

**And now therefore** the Board has determined, based on historical data regarding price changes and to achieve revenue neutrality, it is appropriate to apply, and the Board so orders, forward averaging corrections of:

Gasoline: plus 0.8¢ per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil: plus 0.5¢ per litre

And whereas a winter blending adjustment of plus 3.0¢ per litre is required for ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil;

**And now therefore** the Board prescribes the prices for petroleum products as set forth in Schedule "A" effective on and after 12:01 a.m., February 10, 2012.
