Whereas the purpose of the *Petroleum Products Pricing Regulations* is to ensure just and reasonable prices for specified petroleum products taking into consideration the objectives of preserving the availability of such products in rural areas, stabilizing prices of such products and minimizing the variances in prices of such products across the Province;

And whereas the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board ("Board") considered the manner in which it would proceed to set petroleum product prices in its decision, 2006 NSUARB 108, issued on October 16, 2006;

And whereas the Board revised the wholesale margin effective January 4, 2013, in its decision, 2012 NSUARB 213, issued on December 12, 2012;

And whereas the Board revised the retail margin and the transportation allowance effective October 28, 2016, in its decision, 2016 NSUARB 168, issued on September 26, 2016;

And whereas the average of the average of the daily high and low reported product prices (in Canadian cents) for the period ended July 24, 2019, are:

Grade 1 Regular gasoline 62.48¢ per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil 65.31¢ per litre

Now therefore the Board prescribes the benchmark prices for petroleum products to be:

Gasoline:

Grade 1 62.48¢ per litre
Grade 2 65.48¢ per litre
Grade 3 68.48¢ per litre
Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil 65.31¢ per litre

And now therefore the Board has determined, based on historical data regarding price changes and to achieve revenue neutrality, it is appropriate to apply, and the Board so orders, forward averaging corrections of:

Gasoline: minus 0.30¢ per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil: minus 0.30¢ per litre

And now therefore the Board prescribes the prices for petroleum products as set forth in Schedule "A" effective on and after 12:01 a.m., Friday, July 26, 2019.

Small Claims Court Forms and Procedures Regulations-amendment

Order in Council 2019-204 dated July 30, 2019
Amendment to regulations made by the Governor in Council pursuant to Section 33 of the *Small Claims Court Act*

The Governor in Council on the report and recommendation of the Attorney General and Minister of Justice dated April 18, 2019, and pursuant to Section 33 of Chapter 430 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia, 1989, the *Small Claims Court Act*, is pleased to amend the *Small Claims Court Forms and Procedures Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 17/1993, made by the Governor in Council by Order in Council 93-110, dated February 2, 1993, to waive filing fees for claimants meeting financial eligibility criteria and to make minor updates to improve access to, and the efficiency of, the Small Claims Court, in the manner set forth in Schedule "A" attached to and forming part of the report and recommendation, effective on and after September 3, 2019.

Schedule "A"

Amendment to the Small Claims Court Forms and Procedures Regulations
made by the Governor in Council under Section 33 of Chapter 430 of the Revised Statutes of Nova Scotia,
1989, the Small Claims Court Act

- Section 2 of the *Small Claims Court Forms and Procedures Regulations*, N.S. Reg. 17/1993, made by the Governor in Council by Order in Council 93-110 dated February 2, 1993, is amended by striking out "The fee" and substituting "Except where the fee is waived in accordance with Section 2A, the fee".
- 2 The regulations are further amended by adding the following Section immediately after Section 2:
 - **2A** (1) The clerk of the court must waive the fee for filing a notice of claim if a claimant meets the financial eligibility criteria set out in subsection (2) and completes and files with the clerk an application in Form 14 together with 1 of the following:
 - (a) proof of the claimant's income in the form of
 - (i) a current pay or income assistance or benefit stub, or
 - (ii) a copy of the claimant's most recent income tax return or most recent notice of assessment:
 - (b) if the claimant [is] not receiving any income, a letter signed by their medical doctor, priest or other official confirming that the claimant is not receiving any income and is not surviving from any savings.
 - (2) A claimant meets the financial eligibility criteria for waiving the fee under subsection (1) for filing a notice of claim if the claimant's monthly income is less than or equal to the amount that corresponds to the number of dependants they have, as set out in the following table:

- (3) If a claimant's filing fee is waived under subsection (1), all of the following items and services must be made available to the claimant free of charge:
 - (a) a maximum of 25 photocopies;
 - (b) a maximum of 3 court searches;
 - (c) the administration of oaths for an affidavit of service relating to the claim.
- 3 Subsection 3(1) of the regulations is amended by striking out "10 days" and substituting "20 days".
- 4 (1) Subsection 4(1) of the regulations is amended by
 - (a) striking out "Defence/counterclaim" and substituting "Defence";
 - (b) adding ", Part A" immediately after ["]Form 2["].
 - (2) Section 4 of the regulations is further amended by adding the following subsection immediately after subsection (1):
 - (1A) A Counterclaim shall be in Form 2, Part B.
 - (3) Subsection 4(2) of the regulations is amended by striking out "The fee" and substituting "Except where the fee is waived in accordance with Section 2A, the fee".
- 5 Subsection 5(1) of the regulations is amended by striking out "defence/counterclaim" and substituting "Defence/Counterclaim".
- The regulations are further amended by repealing Forms 1 and 2 and substituting the attached Forms 1 and 2.
- 7 Clause 5(a) of Form 11 of the regulations is amended by
 - (a) striking out "\$415.00" and substituting "\$450.00"; [and]
 - (b) striking out "\$275.00" and substituting "\$330.00".
- 8 The regulations are further amended by adding the attached Form 14 immediately after Form 13.
