- 2 The table entitled "Designations and Descriptions of Official Traffic Signs" in Section 8 of the regulations is amended by
 - (a) adding the following row immediately after the row containing the individual sign designation for RA-1:

RA-1B	Bilingual "Stop" sign
	must have block capital white letters on a red background
	 must contain only the words "STOP" and "ARRÊT"
	• must have the word "STOP" above the word "ARRÊT"

- (b) striking out the row containing the individual sign designation for RA-4L (FYG) and RA-4R (FYG);
- (c) adding ", RB-106, RB-107" immediately after "RB-105" in the row containing the individual sign designation for RB-97, RB-98, RB-99, RB-100, RB-101, RB-102, RB-103, RB-104, RB-105; and
- (d) adding "and truck/trailer combinations" immediately after "Trucks" in the row containing the individual sign designation for R-125.
- 3 The Schedule to the regulations is repealed and the attached Schedule is substituted.

Whereas the purpose of the *Petroleum Products Pricing Regulations* is to ensure just and reasonable prices for specified petroleum products taking into consideration the objectives of preserving the availability of such products in rural areas, stabilizing prices of such products and minimizing the variances in prices of such products across the Province;

And whereas the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board ("Board") considered the manner in which it would proceed to set petroleum product prices in its decision, 2006 NSUARB 108, issued on October 16, 2006;

And whereas the Board revised the wholesale margin effective January 4, 2013, in its decision, 2012 NSUARB 213, issued on December 12, 2012;

And whereas on December 30, 2020, the Board issued an interim order in Matter M09952 increasing the wholesale margin for self-service and full-service gasoline and diesel, on an interim basis, by 2.50 cents per litre (cpl) to a total of 9.15 cpl;

And whereas the Board revised the retail markup and the transportation allowance effective October 28, 2016, in its decision, 2016 NSUARB 168, issued on September 26, 2016, and on February 1, 2021, the Board issued an order in Matter M09727 approving an increase to the minimum self-service and full-service retail markup by 0.3 cpl and to the maximum self-service retail markup by 0.4 cpl, to a total for the minimum of 5.4 cpl, and for the maximum of 7.4 cpl;

And whereas in a decision dated April 15, 2021, in Matter 09727 (2021 NSUARB 50), the Board directed a process to consider a retail markup adjustment mechanism, applied monthly, to address ongoing Covid-19-related reduced sales volumes to ensure just and reasonable prices for petroleum products pending recovery from the pandemic, and on June 2, 2021, the Board issued an order approving the methodology for the monthly adjustment mechanism;

And whereas the average of the average of the daily high and low reported product prices (in Canadian cents) for the period ended July 21, 2021, are:

Grade 1 Regular gasoline 73.22¢ per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil 68.85¢ per litre

Now therefore the Board prescribes the benchmark prices for petroleum products to be:

Gasoline:

Grade 1 73.22¢ per litre
Grade 2 76.22¢ per litre
Grade 3 79.22¢ per litre
Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil 68.85¢ per litre

And now therefore the Board has determined, based on historical data regarding price changes and to achieve revenue neutrality, it is appropriate to apply, and the Board so orders, forward averaging corrections of:

Gasoline: plus 0.3¢ per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil: plus 0.3¢ per litre

And now therefore the Board orders that a monthly adjustment to the retail markup is required to account for the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on current sales volumes, as follows:

Gasoline:

minimum self service and full-service: plus 0.6¢ per litre maximum self-service: plus 0.8¢ per litre

Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil:

minimum self service and full-service: plus 0.2ϕ per litre maximum self-service: plus 0.3ϕ per litre

And now therefore the Board prescribes the prices for petroleum products as set forth in Schedule "A" effective on and after 12:01 a.m., July 23, 2021.

Whereas the purpose of the *Petroleum Products Pricing Regulations* is to ensure just and reasonable prices for specified petroleum products taking into consideration the objectives of preserving the availability of such products in rural areas, stabilizing prices of such products and minimizing the variances in prices of such products across the Province;

And whereas the Nova Scotia Utility and Review Board ("Board") considered the manner in which it would proceed to set petroleum product prices in its decision, 2006 NSUARB 108, issued on October 16, 2006;

And whereas the Board revised the wholesale margin effective January 4, 2013, in its decision, 2012 NSUARB 213, issued on December 12, 2012;

And whereas on December 30, 2020, the Board issued an interim order in Matter M09952 increasing the wholesale margin for self-service and full-service gasoline and diesel, on an interim basis, by 2.50 cents per litre (cpl) to a total of 9.15 cpl;

And whereas the Board revised the retail markup and the transportation allowance effective October 28, 2016, in its decision, 2016 NSUARB 168, issued on September 26, 2016, and on February 1, 2021, the Board issued an order in Matter M09727 approving an increase to the minimum self-service and full-service retail markup by 0.3 cpl and to the maximum self-service retail markup by 0.4 cpl, to a total for the minimum of 5.4 cpl, and for the maximum of 7.4 cpl;

And whereas the average of the average of the daily high and low reported product prices (in Canadian cents) for the period ended July 28, 2021, are:

Grade 1 Regular gasoline 75.50¢ per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil 71.13¢ per litre

Now therefore the Board prescribes the benchmark prices for petroleum products to be:

Gasoline:

Grade 1 75.50¢ per litre Grade 2 78.50¢ per litre Grade 3 81.50¢ per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil 71.13¢ per litre

And now therefore the Board has determined, based on historical data regarding price changes and to achieve revenue neutrality, it is appropriate to apply, and the Board so orders, forward averaging corrections of:

Gasoline: plus 0.80¢ per litre Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil: plus 0.60¢ per litre

And now therefore the Board orders that a monthly adjustment to the retail markup is required to account for the impact of the Covid-19 pandemic on current sales volumes, as follows:

Gasoline:

minimum self service and full-service: plus 0.6¢ per litre maximum self-service: plus 0.8¢ per litre

Ultra-low-sulfur diesel oil:

minimum self service and full-service: plus 0.2¢ per litre maximum self-service: plus 0.3¢ per litre

And now therefore the Board prescribes the prices for petroleum products as set forth in Schedule "A" effective on and after 12:01 a.m., July 30, 2021.
