This is to advise that on *January 8, 2014*, *CELTIC CURRENT LP* registered the BATESTON COMMUNITY WIND PROJECT for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the Environment Act.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to construct a 2.3 MW Community Wind Project at PID 15619596, in the community of Bateson, Cape Breton County, Nova Scotia. This Project consists of one 2.3 MW wind turbine. Construction will commence in the Spring 2014 with operation expected by Fall 2014.
