Second Public Comment Period of Environmental Assessment Report Pursuant to the Nova Scotia *ENVIRONMENT ACT*

This is to advise that the Environmental Assessment Review Panel has determined a public hearing will not be required for the Goldboro liquefied natural gas (LNG) proposal, following the first public comment period ended on December 16, 2013. In the absence of the hearing, the Review Panel requested a written response from the Proponent to the comments received on the proposal. In addition, a second public comment period is now commenced to obtain additional comments on the Environmental Assessment Report and the Proponent's response on the comments.

The proposal entails the development and operation of a natural gas liquefaction plant, LNG tanker terminal, and associated marine facilities in Goldboro, Guysborough County, Nova Scotia. The project is being designed to provide an LNG send-out capacity of 10 million tonnes per annum (Mtpa) and a gross LNG tank storage capacity of approximately 690,000 cubic metres (m³). The proposal also includes the development of a 180 megawatt (MW) on-site gas-fired power plant.
