

# NOTICE

## Registration of Undertaking for Environmental Assessment ENVIRONMENT ACT

This is to advise that on November 1, 2023, Kmt nuk Wind Ltd. registered the KMTNUK WIND POWER PROJECT for environmental assessment, in accordance with Part IV of the Environment Act.

The purpose of the proposed undertaking is to construct and operate a 16 turbine, 98 MW wind project. The wind turbines will be 206.5 m tall to the tip of the blade and individually produce up to 7.0 MW. The Project is located in Colchester County, north of McCallum Settlement, NS, and will also involve the construction of access roads, a substation, electrical collector and transmission lines and temporary laydown areas. The Project intends to begin construction in 2024 and is expected to be operational for 35 years commencing in 2025.
