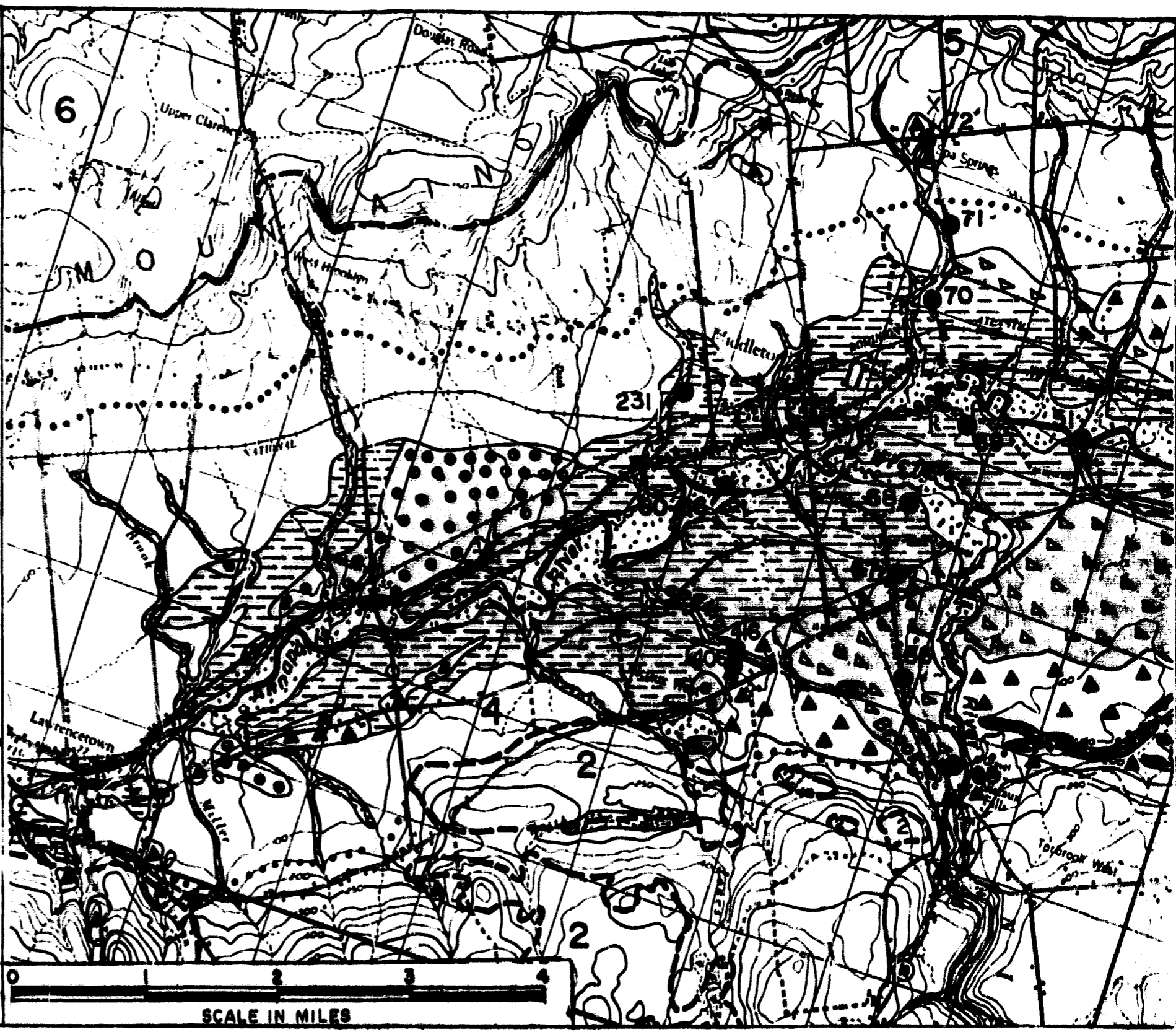


FIGURE 2. General geology of the Nictaux West - Middleton area.
