Part of area (at Glen Rd) is regenerating younger stands and is under the Port Hawkesbury Paper license

Part of area is owned by a forestry company

Medium mineral potential. Part of the area is licensed for mineral exploration

Medium wind potential

A portion is subject to lands being acquired by the Province. Legal protection of Rogart Mountain portion (187 ha) subject to addressing mineral rights.
