## Overview

Forest patch representing Aspen Drumlin Plain natural Landscape

## Ecological Values

Best opportunity for representation of the Aspen Drumlin Plain Natural Landscape

Contains many productive forest drumlins

Although mostly second growth forest there are a few patches of potentially old tolerant hardwood

Habitat for provincially endangered mainland moose and nationally threatened and provincially vulnerable wood turtle

## Outdoor Recreation Values

Potential backcountry hiking destination on the Trans Canada Trail

Hunting, fishing, camping and trapping

## Forestry Values

Contains mature stands of hardwood and mixedwood, with some scattered softwood

Small portion of area currently unavailable for forestry due to DNR old forest policy

## Other Resource Values

Low mineral potential

Low petroleum potential

Low wind potential

## Conditions

Legal protection of portion (182 ha) subject to wood supply analysis.

## Exclusions and Vehicle Access

Rail trail and pipeline corridor excluded
