Beautiful beach park near metro Halifax-Dartmouth featuring three white sand crescent beaches on a rugged coastal headland

Provincially and regionally significant beach in proximity to metro; well-used; provincially significant coastal hiking opportunity

Other Site Considerations


Susceptible to coastal processes (storm events with high tide surge or wind driven waves) that cause site erosion.
